We will be departing Houston at 8:05 pm on Continental FL 1089 and will arrive Midland International at 9:27 pm, Wednesday, August 6.

5. Clothing

Scouts will be required to be in Class A uniform during all travel and at other times to be designated. Class B uniform (T shirt & scout pants) will be worn at all other times. Caps are required for both Class A & B uniforms. The only exception is if a scout wants to do the obstacle course he may bring a set of old clothes.

The participation in the obstacle will be the **Only** time a scout may wear something other than scout clothing.

- 8. Meeting Tuesday evening (July 22) at Holiday Inn refer to Ray Vaden's letter.
- 9. Please remind all scouts about things not to say or joke about in airports, federal buildings, etc. I do not want to have to call you and inform you of which federal agency has custody of your son.
- 10. Trading items small inexpensive items to trade are recommended along with extra jamboree council strips.
- 11. Visitors visitors are welcome at jamboree especially on show days. Please let us know if you, a friend or a relative plan to visit us at jamboree.
- 12. Camping Equipment Please review the list of equipment to make sure you have everything.
- 13. Meals We need to know about any special dietary needs or requirements now and not at 5:00 am at the airport.
- 14. Behavior Just a reminder that all the scouts have signed contracts. All of the youth and adult leaders will hold you to those contracts. Remember you are representing Boy Scouts of America and Buffalo Trail Council. Act accordingly.
- 15. Equipment Black duffle bag is due in the council office by 4:30 pm, July 11, 1997.
- 16. Truck Loading Every jamboree scout in Andrews, Big Spring, Midland and Odessa is expected to be at the council office at 9:00 am, Saturday, July 19 to load the truck.
- 17. ID Need a picture ID. You might, also, include your scout registration card.
- 18. Fan A battery powered fan for your tent is recommended.
- 19. Carpet A small piece of carpet is recommended for your tent.
- 20. Scout guide Read the enclosed guide.

We are all going to have a great time and I am looking forward to going with you. Remember we will have fun.
